A generator was purchased in November 2010 to send to Saora Bible College. A trailer was built on which to do the transportation and the generator was then shipped to Honiara in early 2011. In March I travelled over to collect the generator, install it and put a shed over it at Saora. This was done with the help of Colin Stacey and a number of the local men. Pictured below are the generator, then leaving the docks in Honiara and the handover to the Principal of the College



In June of this year I will lead a team of approximately 10 men to Saora to continue the work. The aim is to build a transit house with a water tank under it and also some more cottages for the students and their families.. Of course this will incur considerable cost and currently regular sausage sizzles are being held and on May 14th there was a special dinner also, to raise funds to carry out these tasks. Why does God call us to carry out this work? We believe it is for the extension of His Kingdom. The people who are going through and will go through Saora are being trained as Pastors, Missionaries and Evangelists to carry out His work in the Solomon Islands and throughout the Whole World.
