Notes:

1. The abbreviation SI indicates the name of a Solomon Islander. PI indicates the name of people from other Pacific islands.
2. Florence Young used the term 'Boys' to identify men from the Solomon Islands or other Pacific islands. In this index, the term has been replaced by 'Solomon Islanders'.
3. Place names in *Pearls from the Pacific* have been retained, although modern usage may have altered, especially in China. However, a few errors have been corrected, both in the index and in the version of the book prepared for going on-line.
4. Place names in the Solomon Islands have been identified with the suffix 'Sol. Is.'
5. The names and initials of members of the Deck and Young families are as given in Patricia Braga, *Henry and Catherine, a family tree* (Beecroft, 2003), reprinted 2005.
6. The relationship of members of these families to Florence Young is indicated.
7. The Malayta Company, so spelt by Florence's brothers who founded it, was named for the island of Malaita. The variant spelling has been retained for the company name in the index.
8. Illustrations are indicated in *italics*. The page referred to is facing the photograph.
9. The spelling of a few place names, e.g., Nongosila (Ngongosila), has been adjusted in accordance with forms used by Dr Clive Moore, *Mala Before Auki: Malaita Province, Solomon Islands up to the beginning of the Protectorate Government*, December 2006.

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
